

BRYAN HELLER

Bryan Heller is a professional concert pianist and instructor who lives in Cashiers, North Carolina. Originally from West Palm Beach, Florida, he received music education from the Alexander Dreyfoos Jr. School of the Arts, and Western Carolina University where he earned a Bachelor of Music degree. Bryan is active in this region as the Director of Music for Cashiers United Methodist Church, and accompanist for both the Cashiers Community Chorus and the Highlands Community Chorus. His PianoMountain studio currently educates music students from 5 to 85. He is an established performer for weddings and private concerts. One of his greatest moments has been performing at Carnegie Hall accompanying the Smoky Mountain High School Concert Choir.

Friends of the Library Salutes the Bibliophiles' 20th Anniversary Season

In December, 2004, Ethan Staats and a group of avid readers from among the Friends of the Library formed the library's book group, Bibliophiles. Since then, the group read over 170 books, mostly novels. Ranging from old favorites like Harper Lee's To Kill a Mockingbird and John Steinbeck's The Grapes of Wrath to newer works by Toni Morrison, Ian McEwen, Ron Rash and Ann Patchett, the selected books were usually award winners. Reading the books led to lively discussion by Cashiers residents and visitors, nine times each year.

To celebrate its 20th season, Bibliophiles will meet on the second Wednesday of the month at 5:30 pm from September, 2024 to May, 2025. You can join the discussion in-person in the library's community room, or virtually using the library's advanced remote meeting set up. Join in even if you have not read the month's selected book.
